These Qualifications represent most of the crafts' rules when submitting applications for apprenticeships.

#### **Qualifications**

1. Be a minimum of 18 years of age.
2. Complete an application form and submit processing fee (Every local has different monetary amounts some no fee at all).
3. Be a high school graduate, or have a GED.
4. Must reside in the local union's area/jurisdiction.
5. Possess a valid Driver's License and have reliable transportation.
6. Must be able to speak, write and read the English language.
7. Must pass a personal interview and or an aptitude test.
8. Qualify by passing written tests. (Every local has different tests)
9. Every local requires 3-5 years of classroom study in conjunction with working.
10. Must pass drug screening; must pass a physical exam and be able to do the crafts work.
11. Must be a legal resident of the United States.
12. Must show copy of a DD-214 (armed forces discharge).

**Originals of birth certificate, driver's license, Social Security Card, High School Diploma or Transcripts or GED MUST be submitted upon application**

Apprenticeship programs will not discriminate against apprenticeship applicants or apprentices based on race, color, religion, national origin, sex (including pregnancy and gender identity), sexual orientation, genetic information, or because they are an individual with a disability or a person 40 years old or older.
